The call for proposals closed on 26/03/2015. The Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA) received 212 eligible applications for this action.

A panel of external experts assisted the Evaluation Committee in the evaluation of your application against the award criteria indicated in the Call for proposals. The selection decision is based on the quality of the application, its relative position in comparison with the other applications submitted and the budget available. Applications were assessed on a scale from 0 to 100 and were ranked according to merit.

The funding threshold for this action has been set at 86/100 points.
