

How To Come To University of Cordoba Information Package v.7.

Included in this Information Package you will find some useful information about:

- how to come to *Cordoba*, from either *Madrid* or *Sevilla* or *Malaga* or *Barcelona* airports.
- how to get the *Campus de Rabanales* (University) once in *Cordoba*.

I. MADRID → CORDOBA

You can travel by coach or by train from Madrid to Cordoba.

You will need to go from Madrid “*Barajas*” Airport to “*Atocha*” **Railway** Station (“*Estación de Atocha*”) to take a **train** or to the Southern **Coach** Station (“*Estación Sur de Autobuses*”) if you prefer to travel by **coach**.

1. FROM MADRID “*BARAJAS*” AIRPORT TO:

- “*ATOCHA*” **Railway** Station
- “*ESTACIÓN SUR*” **Coach** Station

There are two main options:

1. **By Taxi:** This option could be the most convenient for those travelling with heavy luggage, although it is the most expensive one.

- Trip duration: 40-50 minutes (depending on traffic conditions)
- Price: 25-35€

Walk outside the airport terminal to the taxi ranks. Do not accept offers from drivers inside the terminal, since they are often illegal drivers and you will almost certainly get ripped off. Nevertheless, for avoiding any problems, you should ask for the taxi bill.

2. **Cercanías (short distance train):**

- **Going to “Atocha” Railway Station:**

- CERCANÍAS →

1. From T4: You have to buy the ticket to “*Atocha*” station and take the line C1 that stop there. Check timetables in www.renfe.es/cercanias
2. From T1, T2 or T3: There are free buses to arrive to T4 station and take the Cercanías train to Atocha.
 - Trip duration: 25 minutes (Cercanías) Price: 2,15€ (Cercanías)

○ Going to “Estación Sur” Coach Station:



• CERCANÍAS →

1. From T4: You have to buy the ticket to “Méndez Álvaro” station and take the line C1 that stop there. Check timetables in www.renfe.es/cercanias
2. From T1, T2 or T3: There are free buses to arrive to T4 station and take the Cercanías train to “Méndez Álvaro”.
 - Trip duration: 30 minutes (Cercanías) Price: 2,15€ (Cercanías)

2. TRAVELLING TO CORDOBA:

➤ BY TRAIN

Once you have arrived to the “Atocha-Renfe” Metro station or “Atocha” station if you travelled by train, you must leave the Metro area or Cercanías Area and look for the ticket office situated in the AVE Area.

There are different types of trains you can take there: AVE or ALTARIA (both high speed trains)

- Trip durations:

AVE:	1:45h	
ALTARIA:	2:05h	
- Prices:

AVE: 68,90€	}	Tourist class
ALTARIA/ALVIA: 53,70€		

If you show your flight ticket you can obtain a reduction of 25% of the full price.
- Departing times:

AVE:	Departing from “Atocha” at least every hour
ALTARIA/ALVIA:	8:05, 8:35, 09:05, 15:05, 16:10, 17:05, 18:05

Please note that on Saturdays and Sundays not all the AVE services are operated. You can check timetables and buy tickets on line in www.renfe.es

➤ BY COACH

Once you are at the “Mendez Álvaro” Metro or Cercanías station, you have to go up and to look for the coach ticket offices at the Station. Ask for the “Sercobus / Socibus” desk, where you can buy the ticket to Cordoba.

- Trip duration: 5:00h
- Price: 15,70€
- Departing Times: 1:00, 9:00, 10:00, 14:00, 16:00, 20:00

Please, check timetables in www.socibus.es

II. SEVILLA → CORDOBA

You can travel from *Sevilla* to *Cordoba* by coach or by train.

You have to go from Sevilla “*San Pablo*” Airport to “*Santa Justa*” **Railway** Station (to take a **train**) or to “*El Prado*” **Bus** and **Coach** Station (to take a **coach**).

1. FROM SEVILLA “SAN PABLO” AIRPORT TO:

- “*SANTA JUSTA*” **Railway** Station
- “*EL PRADO*” **Coach** Station

There are different options:

1. **By Taxi:** This option could be the most convenient for those travelling with heavy luggage, although it is the most expensive one.

- Trip duration: 15-20 minutes (depending on traffic conditions)
- Price: 20-25€

Walk outside the airport terminal to the taxi ranks. Do not accept offers from drivers inside the terminal, since they are often illegal drivers and you will almost certainly get ripped off. Nevertheless, for avoiding any problems, you should ask for the taxi bill.

2. **Taking a Bus:** In the airport look for the “*Aeropuerto-Sevilla*” Line Bus Stop

- Trip duration: 20-30 minutes
- Price: 2,40 €
- Timetables: Departing every half an hour (less during Saturdays and Sundays)
- If you go to “*Santa Justa*” **Railway** Station you have to stop at the first stop: “*Santa Justa* Station”.
- If you go to “*El Prado*” **Bus** and **Coach** Station you have to stop at the last stop and to walk to the Bus Station for 5-10 minutes, as showed in the map below.



2. TRAVELLING TO CORDOBA:

➤ BY TRAIN

Once you are at “Santa Justa” Railway Station look for the ticket office where you can buy a ticket to Cordoba.

There are three types of trains you can take: i) Andalucía Express, ii) ALTA VELOCIDAD and iii) AVE.

- Duration: Andalucía Express: 1:30h
ALTA VELOCIDAD: 0:45h
AVE: 0:42h
 - Prices: Andalucía Express: 8,60 €
ALTA VELOCIDAD: 12,80€
AVE: 26,50€ - 29,40€ } Tourist class
- If you show your flight ticket you can obtain a reduction of 25% of the full price in AVE Trains.
- Timetables: ANDALUCIA EXPRESS: 7.50, 9.00, 13.25, 15.00, 18.48, 20:10, 21:35
ALTA VELOCIDAD: 6:40, 7:45, 9:30, 12:30, 15:30, 18:45, 20:30
AVE: Departing every hour

You can check timetables and buy tickets on line in www.renfe.es

➤ **BY COACH:**

Once you are at “El Prado” Bus Station you have to look for the “Alsina Graells” (name of the Coaches Company) ticket office, where you can buy the ticket to Cordoba.

- Duration: 2:00h
- Price: 10,63€
- Timetables: 08:30, 09:00, 13:30, 15:00, 16:15, 18:00, 22:00

Please note that on Saturdays and Sundays probably all the services may not operated. You can check timetables and buy tickets on line in www.alsa.es

III. MALAGA → CORDOBA

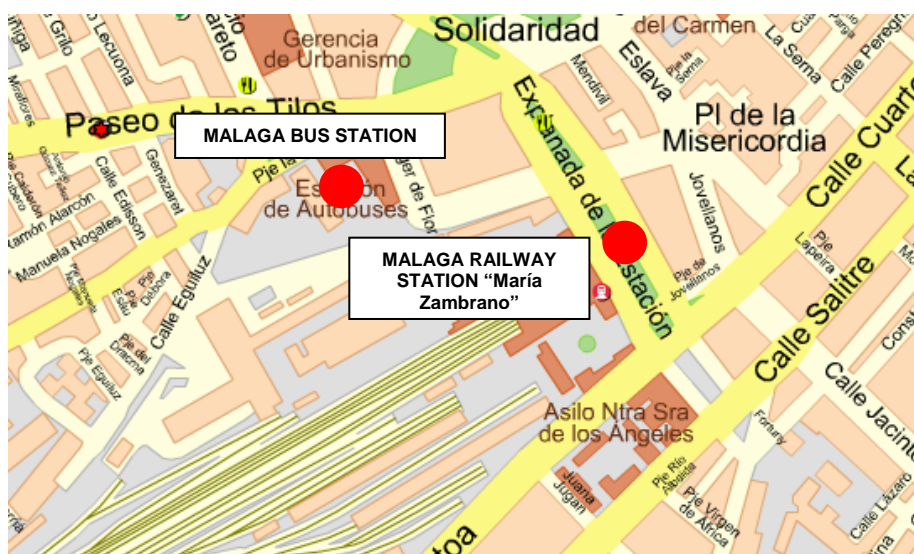
You can go from Málaga to Córdoba by coach or by train.

First of all you will need to go from Málaga Airport to Malaga **Railway** Station “María Zambrano” (to take a **train**) or to Málaga **Bus** Station (to take a **coach**).

1. FROM MÁLAGA AIRPORT TO:

- **MALAGA Railway** Station
- **MALAGA Bus** Station

Both stations are within a walking distance, as you can see in the map below.



There are three options to get these two stations from the airport:

1. **By Taxi:** This option could be the most convenient for those travelling with heavy luggage, although it is the most expensive one.

- Duration: 15-20 minutes
- Price: 20-25€

Walk outside the airport terminal to the taxi ranks. Do not accept offers from drivers inside the terminal, since they are often illegal drivers and you will almost certainly get ripped off. Nevertheless, for avoiding any problems, you should ask for the taxi bill.

2. **Taking a “Cercanías” Train (Short Distance Train):** Please, look for the train Station. Once you are at “Aeropuerto” station, take the C1 Line, towards Malaga city.

- Trip duration: 15 minutes
- Price: 1,40€ / 2,95 € (depending on the day)
- Departing time: every half an hour Check timetables in www.renfe.es/cercanias

You have to stop at “*Malaga María Zambrano*” station (the last one). Once there:

- If you prefer to travel to Córdoba by **train** you only have to leave the “*Cercanías*” Area and to look for the long-distance trains Area, within the same railway station.
- If you want to go to the Bus Station, you have to leave the Railway Station and to walk for 5 -10 minutes as showed in the map above.

3. **By Bus,** Look for the Bus Stop of Bus Line number 19, In the airport

- Trip duration: 20 minutes
- Price: 1,40€
- Timetables: Departing every half an hour

You have to call at “*Estación de Autobuses*” stop. You are at the City Centre Coach Station. If you want to go to the Train Station you have to walk for 5-10 minutes, as showed in the map above.

2. TRAVELLING TO CORDOBA:

➤ BY TRAIN

Once you are at Malaga Railway “María Zambrano” Station, there are mainly two types of trains you can take: ALTA VELOCIDAD and AVE.

- Duration: ALTA VELOCIDAD: 1:05h
AVE: 1:00h
- Prices: ALTA VELOCIDAD: 22,40€
AVE: 45,70€ } Tourist class

If you show your flight ticket you can obtain a reduction of 25% of the full price in AVE Trains.

- Timetables: ALTA VELOCIDAD: 6:45, 9:10, 14:30, 16:15, 18:20, 20:15
AVE: 6:20, 8:05, 8:20, 9:00, 11:05, 12:05,
14:05, 15:05, 16.50, 17:00, 20:30

You can check timetables and buy tickets on line in www.renfe.es

➤ BY COACH

Once you are at Malaga Bus Station you have to look for the “*Alsina Graells*” (name of the Line) ticket office, where you can buy the ticket to Cordoba.

- Duration: 2:00h
- Price: 23,52€
- Departing times: 9:00, 11:30, 16:30, 19:30, 20:00

Please note that on Saturdays and Sundays probably all the services may not operated. You can check timetables and buy tickets on line in www.alsa.es

IV. BARCELONA → CORDOBA

You can travel by coach or by train from Barcelona to Cordoba.

You will need to go from Barcelona “El Prat” Airport to “Barcelona Sants” **Railway Station** to take a **train** or to the **Coach Station** (“*Barcelona Nord*”) if you prefer to travel by **coach**.

1. FROM BARCELONA “EL PRAT” AIRPORT TO:

- “BARCELONA SANTS” **Railway Station**
- “BARCELONA NORD” **Coach Station**

There are two main options:

1. **By Taxi:** This option could be the most convenient for those travelling with heavy luggage, although it is the most expensive one.
 - Trip duration: 25-35 minutes (depending on traffic conditions)
 - Price: 25-35€

Walk outside the airport terminal to the taxi ranks. Do not accept offers from drivers inside the terminal, since they are often illegal drivers and you will almost certainly get ripped off. Nevertheless, for avoiding any problems, you should ask for the taxi bill.

2. **Taking the “Cercanías” (short distance train):**

In Barcelona there are 6 “Cercanías” lines named from 1 to 7 and 10 line (check www.tmb.net) and which are represented by different colors. After arrival to *El Prat Airport*:

The line you have to take is Line R-10 (marked with brown color) in the direction to “*Barcelona Sants*”.

- Going to “Barcelona Sants” Railway Station:
 - You have come to your destiny
 - Trip duration: 20 minutes
 - Price: 3,40€
- Going to “Barcelona Nord” Coach Station:
 - CERCANÍAS → Continue to “*Barcelona sants*” station and change there to line R-1 or R-3 or R-4 or R-7 and stop at “*Arc the Triomf*” station .Check timetables in www.tmb.cat
 - Trip duration: 30-45 minutes (Cercanías)
 - Price: 3,40€

➤ **TRAVELLING TO CORDOBA:**

➤ **BY TRAIN**

Once you have arrived to “*Barcelona Sants*” station if you travel by train, you must leave the *Cercanías* Area and look for the ticket office situated in the AVE Area.

There are different types of trains you can take there: AVE or ARCO or TRENHOTEL

- Trip durations: AVE: 4:38h
ARCO: 09:34h
- Prices: AVE: 139,00€
ALARIS: 66,30€ } Tourist class
If you show your flight ticket you can obtain a reduction of 25% of the full price.
- Departing times: AVE: 8:15, 10:20, 15:50, 15:50 (direct trains)
Departing every hour trains to Madrid where you can connect with other services from Madrid to Cordoba

ALARIS: 8:30

Please note that on Saturdays and Sundays not all the AVE services are operated. You can check timetables and buy tickets online in www.renfe.es

➤ **BY COACH**

Once you are at “*Barcelona Nord*” station (www.barcelonanord.com), you have to look for the coach ticket offices at the Station. Ask for the “ALSA” desk, where you can buy the ticket to Cordoba.

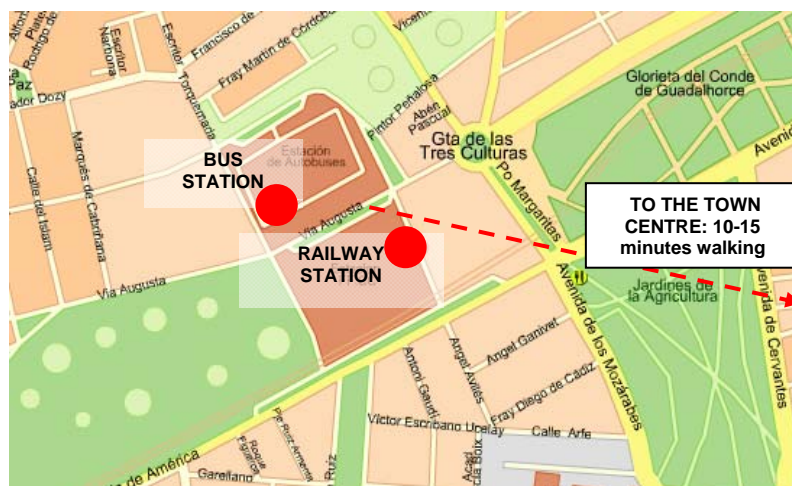
- Trip duration: 13:15h
- Price: 70,23€ - 80,35€
- Departing Times: 16:30, 22:30

V. CORDOBA → CAMPUS DE RABANALES (UNIVERSITY)

WELCOME TO CÓRDOBA!

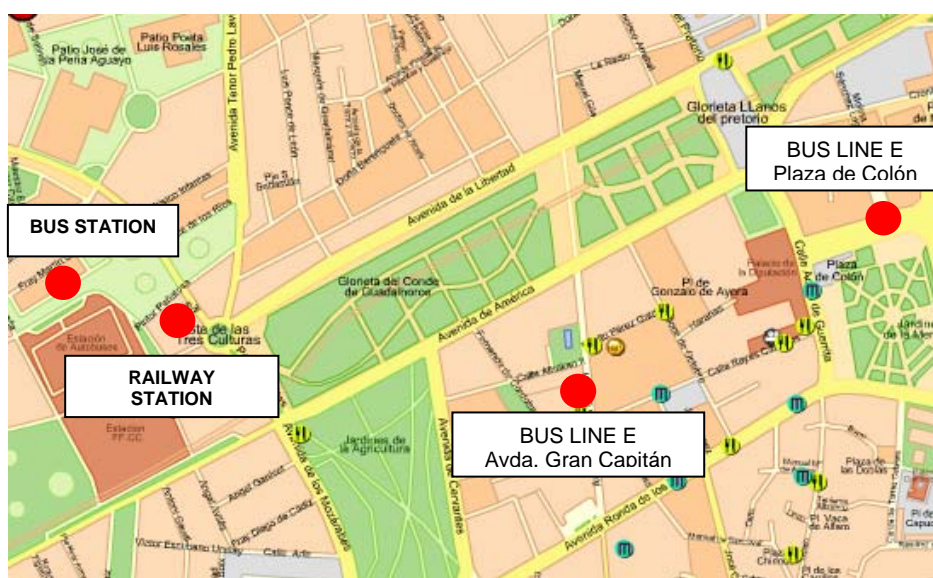
The Cordoba Central Railway Station is in front of the Bus Station, and at less of 15 minutes walk from downtown, as showed in the map below:



The Master headquarters are located in the “*Campus de Rabanales*” (University of Cordoba), only 7km far from City Centre.

You can reach it using public transport:

- **By Train** (5-7 minutes trip). You can take the special line “*Rabanales*” at the Cordoba Central Railway Station. Note that during September only few trains operate. Please, ask for info at the Railways Company (“*RENFE*”) information office.



- **By Bus** (20-30 minutes trip). Line E (every hour). You can check timetables in http://www.ayuncordoba.es/portal/web/listaPDF_b.jsp?id=38015

The main Bus Stop is located in *Plaza de Colón*, in the town centre. You can also take the bus in other stops like in *Avda. Gran Capitán*.

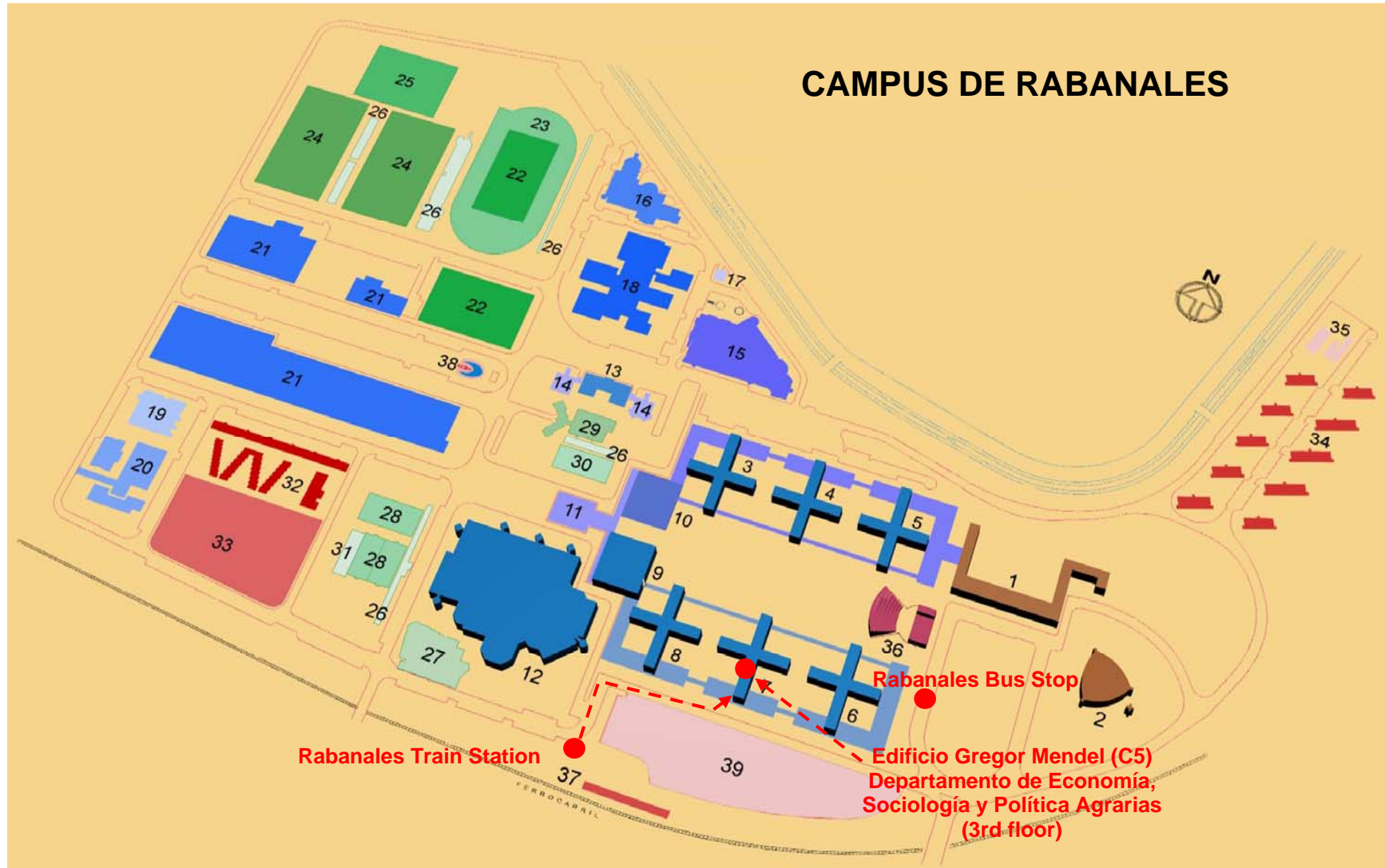
