



Report on Workshop

„ BARIERS AND STIMULI IN LAND MANAGEMENT”

The workshop took place on 14-15th December 2017 in building of the Faculty of Economics and Management (University of Bialystok) and was organized by the Faculty as a event of project SULANET. About 50 persons participated in the workshop.

The aim of the workshop was presenting main problems of functioning of the agricultural land market in Poland. During the workshop a few problems were presented:

- Leasing of agricultural land in Poland – dr hab. Adam Sadowski, associate professor
- Agricultural land market in Poland – dr hab. Renata Przygodzka, associate professor
- Withdrawal of agricultural land in Poland – dr Jarosław Mioduszewski from University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn
- Land consolidation in Poland – dr hab. Renata Przygodzka, associate professor
- Problem of the inheritance in the Polish farming – dr hab. Adam Sadowski, associate professor
- Social and economics results of direct payments in Poland – prof. Wojciech Florkowski from University of Georgia

The workshop was opened by dr. hab. prof. UwB Adam Sadowski. The workshop was divided into two parts (one in first day of workshop, and second in next day). In every part three problems were presented and after that it was time for questions and discussion. Many persons took part in discussion and it is possible to say that land management is important aspects of the Polish economy and agriculture.
