Comenius University Bratislava, Faculty of Law would hereby like to invite you to the 12th year of the international academic conference "Bratislava Legal Forum 2026" which will be held from **17 to 18 September 2026** (Thursday to Friday) in the premises of the Faculty of Law, Comenius University Bratislava.

The primary topic of the plenary session is "**Sustainability of Business Activity in the EU in the Context of Environmental Protection**".

The main aim of the conference is to create a space and platform for discussion between all legal professions on the one hand and academics on the other. The conference is, in accordance with the aforementioned aim, divided into a **plenary session and parallel discussions conducted in topic-based sections**. The aim of this conference is also to deepen international cooperation and formulate scientific results.
